Blessed Miriam Teresa (1901-1927): A Saint from NJ

On November 14, 2014, a young Sister of Charity, a graduate of the College of St. Elizabeth in Madison, NJ, was proclaimed "Blessed" by the Catholic Church at Sacred Heart Cathedral, Newark. It was the first beatification to take place in the United States. Miriam Teresa Demjanovich was born in Bayonne, NJ, the youngest of seven children. She died in 1927, at the age of 26, as a novice of the Sisters of Charity of St. Elizabeth, making her vows on her death bed. In her short life, she received special favors from God. As a college student, she had a vision of the Blessed Mother and after she entered the convent, St. Therese once appeared to her and walked with her in the convent garden. Her message to us, proclaimed in her writings, is that all people are called to holiness as described in John 14:23: "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him and we shall come to him and make our home in him." RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)

In a spirit of love, the church welcomes those who are interested in discovering the richness of our Catholic faith to come together to discuss their personal journey toward God. The Rite of Christian initiation or RCIA is for:

- ◇ Those who were baptized in other faith traditions, but now feel called to become Christian.
- ◇ Those who have never been baptized or do not belong to a faith tradition, but now feel called to become Catholic.
- ◇ Those who were baptized Catholic, but never received First Holy Communion and Confirmation.
- ◇ Those who have received both Catholic baptism and First Holy Communion, but were never confirmed.

This discernment process typically runs from September through Easter. If you are interested in becoming Catholic or know of someone who might be interested, please contact Sister Immacolata.
